WE DESIGN SPACES IN WHICH PEOPLE CAN GROW

Large spaces – but barely any people using them. Spaces that are functional – but not inspiring. Relics of a working world that no longer meets today's requirements.



Yet instead of simply make spaces smaller or hanging a few new pictures, we decided to invest into the future of our working worlds. Our aim was to create spaces that will invite employees back into the office. Spaces that encourage workers to exchange ideas, give them opportunities to unwind and allow for vibrant interactions.





WHAT DO PEOPLE NEED TO MAKE COMING INTO THE OFFICE A JOY RATHER THAN A CHORE?

We implemented this project in three phases with Interstuhl's very own holistic approach to room solutions:

PLANNING NEEDS UNDERSTANDING

We analysed what New Work means for us and derived specific requirements from this.



PLANNING AND DESIGN

Based on these insights, we developed a suitable room concept that combines functionality, atmosphere and flexibility.

U3IMPLEMENTATION AND SUPPORT

We rigorously implemented this concept, including planning and project management and also supported the team during their first steps in the new workspaces.

The results became evident after a very short time: people enjoy being in the office again and come in more frequently. Because what is waiting for them is a room concept that is based on the reality of actual work and not outdated assumptions.

MAKING WORK EASIER WITH THE RIGHT ZONES

A space for actual work, not just a concept on paper: old boundaries and rigid structures were broken up. We moved away from long hallways and tiny cubicles to open, inviting zones that encourage networking. Each zone has its own clearly defined function:

- Work zones for focused work
- Meet zones for rapidly exchanging ideas
- Create zones for innovative impulses
- Relax zones for mental regeneration



Desk sharing has become a permanent fixture, as is allows for a flexible workspace concept that adapts to the requirements of our team to the greatest possible extent. Every area fulfils several functions and can be booked flexibly as needed. This allows everyone to work exactly where they need to be to really flourish.

In addition to the acoustics and materials, colour and light concepts that support and emotionally reinforce the functions of the individual zones also create an ideal environment. The result is the new Interstuhl Liveroom. A space that combines working with living.




WE DON'T JUST RECOMMEND WORK CONCEPTS. WE USE THEM OURSELVES.

From analysis to implementation: the Liveroom was planned, designed and supported by an interdisciplinary team. We utilised the full range of our Interstuhl room solutions, from the digital **goconut** and **intensor** services during analysis, to room planning, through to equipping all zones with our own products, products from network partners and special furniture items made by our in-house carpentry workshop. The result is a work environment that is not staged, but simply works.



The Liveroom is where New Work lives and breathes: with the new room design, our team now consistently spend 80% of their time in the office. This shows that our new Liveroom is used, because it works, because it offers real added value every single day and because it meets the requirements for hybrid work. All that without needing to expand our existing spaces.





This feedback shows that zoning supports focused work and encourages the exchange of ideas across teams. The atmosphere of the new workspace means that employees identify with the office more strongly. The Liveroom is not just accepted but valued.

The Liveroom is not a vision, but a real workspace at the headquarters of the Interstuhl Group. It is both a living test lab and a springboard for innovation and further development.
